## **Softball League 12U League Rules**

Play governed by Babe Ruth Softball rules with the following exceptions:

- Face masks are required on all batting helmets.
- 12U are required to wear fielder's masks when playing any position in the infield.
- The home team is required to provide 2 new balls for the game.
- Game length: 6 innings or 1 hour and 15 minutes time limit; no new inning after 1 hour and 5 minutes.
- Courtesy runner: highly suggested for catcher with 2 outs.
- 10 run mercy rule in effect. The game will be called if at the completion of 4 innings the visiting team is ahead by 10 runs or 3 ½ innings if the home team is ahead by 10.
- Farmville-Greene County Softball League teams will always use a continuous batting order. Free substitution is in place with a continuous batting order. No player can sit 2 consecutive innings.
- 12U Softball will only play 9 defensive players.
- Innings will consist of 3 outs or a maximum of 5 runs per inning in the first 4 innings. During the 5th and 6th innings runs will be unlimited through ten batters.
- Pitches will pitch to players until four balls are acquired then the coach will pitch 3 pitches.
- Time will be called only by the umpire when the lead runner is stopped or abandons their effort to advance. Bringing the ball to pitcher's mound, home plate, or a player calling time does not constitute time. If the defense makes a play on any other runner, then the lead runner is free to run. This will be up to the judgment of the umpire.
- You may play with as few as 7, but must take an out for each player under 9. So if you start with 7 you will have to take 2 outs. If you start with 8 then you will take 1 out.
- Pitching rubber will be set at 35ft, and ball size is 12 in.
- A pitcher may only pitch 3 innings per game or max of 7 in a week. (1 pitch constitutes as an inning). Managers
  are strongly encouraged to focus on pitcher development and to take every opportunity to allow maximum
  participation in pitching
- Coaches are allowed two mound visits during an inning. On the second mound visit a pitching change must be made.
- Tie Breaker Rules: (Tournament Games Only)

At the conclusion of 6 innings of play or the 1 and 15 min. hour time-limit if there is a tie, the following tie breaker will be in effect.

Tie Breaker Rule: At the start of each half inning until a winner is determined, the offensive team will start with a runner on second base who will be the last recorded out from the previous inning. The game will then continue to be played as a regular baseball/softball game.

The game clock will start at the conclusion of the coaches meeting.
